

MEET THE TEACHERS



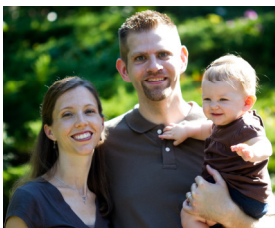
Andi Hogan was saved her first semester at college. She began dancing at The Dance Academy in Fishers at age 12, after quitting competitive gymnastics. Dur-

IN STEP Dance Ministry

The dancers in In Step receive weekly instruction in dance, but the primary focus is to prepare dance pieces for corporate worship, whether it is a regular Sunday morning, Christmas musical or special service such as Missions Conference or Easter.

WHEN? Thursday nights, August through May. This is a year long commitment.

WHO? Previous and/or additional dance training is not required, but highly encouraged for those 8 years old and up. All dancers must be regular attendees or members of CPC. Open to ages 5-adult. Auditions are required for ages 11-adult.

COST? \$30 for the year. Checks should be made to College Park with “dance ministry” written in the memo, due at time of registration.

REGISTRATION? Registration begins June 1 for new dancers and will close when all spots are filled. More information and registration forms are available online.



STEP TRAINING Dance Classes

This alternative to local dance studios offers cost effective pricing, modesty, and consistency in what the In Step dancers are learning. The focus of these classes is training in ballet, lyrical and jazz dance technique.

WHEN? Monday nights. The school year session runs Aug.-April and the summer session runs June –Aug (6 classes total).

WHO? Previous dance training is not required. All dancers must be regular attendees or members of CPC. Open to ages 4-adult. You do not have to take these classes to be in the dance ministry, nor do you have to be in the dance ministry to be in these classes.

COST?
School year—approximately \$210
Summer (intro level, 30 min.) — \$35
Summer (levels 1 & 2, 1 hr.)— \$45
Summer (level 3, 1.5 hrs.)— \$55

Checks should be made to Cassie Pugh and turned in at the time of registration. A payment plan is available for the school year session.
